25 November marks the start of the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence, a global campaign calling for the prevention and elimination of violence against women and girls. The campaign runs for 16 days until 10 December, which is Human Rights Day.

Violence against women and girls affects **one in three women**. It is a global human rights emergency that must stop. Every year, the UN Campaign focuses on a specific theme and this year's is “#NoExcuse for online abuse”. Because there is no excuse. Ever.
