Dear sirs,

It has come to my attention that a late change is being proposed to the City Plan 2040 whereby taller buildings would be permitted outside the designated tall buildings cluster.

I feel this is not consistent with the best interests of the City's stakeholders: workers or residents.

Having tall buildings clustered in one area enables:

- their impact on existing buildings and their users to be mitigated eg loss of light and adverse impact on listed buildings
- Preserves sight lines to St Paul's.
- areas of the City to be put first the needs of residents eg space for their children to play; and allow them to enjoy their homes without being overshadowed.
- services eg utilities and transport links to be focussed where there will be extra footfall.

I am a [REDACTED] resident and feel any such change has not been adequately consulted on and should therefore not be approved.
