Subject: Registering an objection to a proposed exemption to planning in the CoL

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As a resident in the city of London concerned with protecting the rich historical inheritance here, and mindful of the need for appropriate management of that heritage, I am alarmed by news of new exemption that would permit existing 'tall buildings' (over 75m) to be redeveloped to heights even higher, even if they are outside the Tall Buildings Clusters already provided for.

It appears that this has been slipped into the City Plan 2040 that was put forward and consulted on some time ago, but would also include current planning proposals affecting future development on Silk Street as well as in many other adjacent areas. This appears to be an attempt to undermine the right to object to those of us who reside in these areas.

I am stating my objection here to the exemption proposed. The existing tall buildings extent and designation should remain, and certainly not changed in any way without further consultation.
