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I strongly object to the proposed changes to the City Plan 2040 /MM55. Currently the Mayor's plan requires buildings greater than 75m to be clustered together. To allow exceptions for redevelopment of existing buildings makes a mockery of this and the listing that applies to the Barbican estate.

The Barbican is quickly sinking below sub-standard and out of scale development. The quality of life for residents, people who actually have to live with the consequences of poor planning decisions, is diminishing as the sky gradually disappears and privacy is compromised by inappropriate development.

The first approach should always be redevelopment rather than rebuild as this is the environmentally responsible approach. Indeed, the City supposedly has a policy for that too.

Unfortunately, the City priorities financial gain over any other issue, including health & wellbeing of residents, listing rules, or any current policy in place.

If this amendment is made, then shame on you. It would be refreshing for this to be rejected outright but on the City's current form I am extremely concerned.
