## The City of London (One Way Streets) (Amendment No. 26) Order 2025

Made: 10<sup>th</sup> December 2025

Coming into operation: 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026

---

The Common Council of the City of London, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the City of London, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 122 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and section 8 of, and Part I of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The City of London (One Way Streets) (Amendment No. 26) 2025 and shall come into operation on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026.
2. In this Order, “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument, having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The City of London (One Way Streets) Order 2015(c) (as amended) shall have effect as though the provisions of that Order shall apply to the item numbered 1 and set out in the Schedule to this Order as if that item was in Schedule 3 to that Order.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order further amends The City of London (One Way Streets) Order 2015 (as amended), in the City of London by introducing a one-way traffic restriction in Old Jewry from north to south for its entire length, except pedal cycles. It makes the provisions of The City of London (Old Jewry) (No.8) Experimental Order 2024 permanent.
