Amendments to loading restrictions on Moor Lane.


In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London Corporation intend to make the order set out in section 1 to this notice, with the effect set out in section 2 to this notice, by amending the order set out in section 3 to this notice.

1. The following order intends to be made:
 - (a) The City of London (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*
2. The order set out in section 1 to this notice will propose to have the following effect in:
 - (a) **Moor Lane** to extend the existing 'at any time' loading restrictions on both sides, to cover the length of Moor Lane between its junction with Fore Street and a point 8.4 metres north of its junction with Silk Street.
3. The order will be made by amending the following order:
 - (a) The City of London (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Consolidation No. 2) Order 2021
