The City of London (Free Parking Places) (Police) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2026

Made: 13 May 2026

Coming into operation: 22 May 2026

The Common Council of the City of London Corporation, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the City of London, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and section 8 of, and Part I of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The City of London (Free Parking Places) (Police) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2026 and shall come into operation on 22 May 2026.
2. In this Order, “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument, having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The City of London (Free Parking Places) (Police) Order 2007 (as amended) (c) shall have effect as though the items in Schedule 2 to that Order numbered P11 are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order further amends The City of London (Free Parking Places) (Police) Order 2007 (as amended), in the City of London in:-

- (a) **Wood Street** to revoke the police parking place on the north-west side outside No. 88 Wood Street.
