Just before Christmas, I was delighted to meet with the Ambassador of Vietnam.

There is already a very good relationship between the UK and Vietnam, and I was pleased to talk to the Ambassador about how we can build on this relationship further, through Financial Services, FinTech, Sustainable Finance and Professional Services.

I also met with the Ambassador of Chile, one of the City of London Corporation's key partners in Latin America.

They are one of the leaders in sustainability – launching the world's first sustainability linked bond on the London Stock Exchange, and I discussed with the Ambassador how our sustainable financial services can help them achieve even more in 2023.

I visited New York City to encourage greater partnership between the UK and US's financial and professional services firms, which can help drive investment, growth and prosperity for us both.

I met with leading financial institutions, including the CEOs of Blackrock and JP Morgan, alongside Goldman Sachs, Lord Abbett, Citibank and with the CEO of Bloomberg just before the visit.

I also hosted a British-American Reception focused on the City's Global Investment Futures Campaign, outlining the strength and skill of our investment management sector, which is second only to the United States. Later today, I will be hosting the Mayor of London for our annual 'London Government Dinner' held at the Mansion House.

I look forward to outlining to our guests how the City of London supports Londoners and outlining how our financial services sector supports Londoners and the wider country.

Later this month, I will be visiting Scotland where I will be meeting with the leaders of the UK's second largest financial services hub, as well as the First Minister, followed by visits to the Republic of Ireland and Australia.
